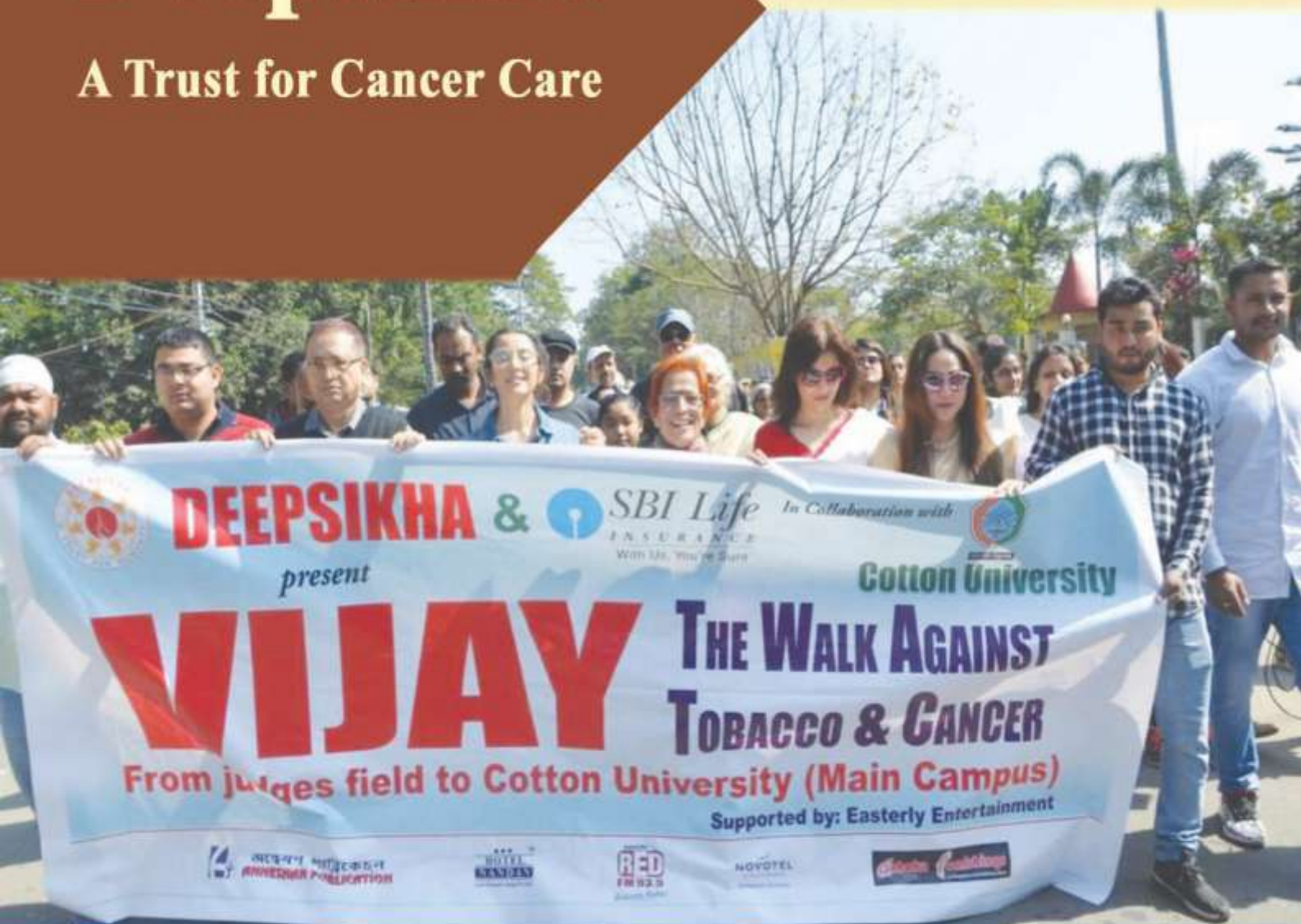

Impact Report ...



Deepsikha's Annual report for the year 2022-23 represents the collective efforts of everyone involved in trying to make a difference in the lives of those who need us at their time of crisis. The activities spanned the spectrum of cancer care- from awareness to screening, providing financial aid, accommodation, food, transport to patients and their families and meeting the challenges of preventing cancer.

The highlights of the year were:

- Free breast cancer screening of 1000 women in the district of Morigaon, Guwahati Assam with financial assistance from Healthium Medtech, Bangalore.
- Donation of an Ambulance by Assam Carbon limited in Guwahati.
- The Lions Club of Narengi has been supporting our cause by way of providing protein powder to our patients.
- The family of Dr. Harichandra Kalita offered to provide the furnitures and fixtures in our cafeteria in the loving memory of Dr. Kalita who was a gynecologist par excellence.
- We celebrated world No tobacco with a street play in different locations of Guwahati which was directed by one of our staff.
- The Sishu Ashray Sthal has been able to touch the lives of our children and regular art , craft and study classes helps our children to cope up with the stress. Till now we have made our services available to 3898 children along with their parents . The centre offers free accommodation, food and transportation including 24x7 free ambulance service with support from SBI Life.
- The hospice centre which is absolutely free for terminally ill patients along with their attendants is a respite for the family as we provide free palliative treatment under the guidance of our pain and palliative physician as otherwise they would have gone back home to live a life in excruciating pain.
- Alongwith patients homes Navi Mumbai for cancer patients Deepsikha also provides accommodation, transport and other facilities to patients and their attending members from Arunachal Pradesh under an agreement with the State Government in Kalamboli.
- Glowderma labs and Balkrishna Industries have contributed for the purchase of food grains, grocery and free meals to patients at Deepsikha's bhawans in sector 19 and 28.
- A step forward by Deepsikha by way of facilitating free dormitories and bus for transporting cancer patients at Assam Bhawan Mumbai.
- Special thanks to SBIMF, India Carbon Ltd, Trinity Fructa, Oil India Limited, Maniyar Group of Industries, Rotary Club of Gauhati West, BCPL, BCPT, Bhojraj Hassomal, Galaxy Surfactants for their magnanimous support.

There had been challenges and success in our journey, a journey of sweat and toil. Every member and staff of Deepsikha has adhered to their commitment towards the cause of cancer and have tried to bring about a change to the extent possible .Deepsikha remains ever grateful to all individuals, organizations, corporate donors hospitals, volunteers , advisors who stood by us and whose help in many forms has enable us to reach out and be by the side of patients . Our Services to Cancer Patients

- Voluntary service at B. Barooah Cancer Hospital and Tata Memorial Hospital Help Desk cum Enquiry Counter.
- Providing free accommodation to needy cancer patients at Deepsikha's Sishu Ashray Sthal in Guwahati, shelter home in Dibrugarh, hospice centre in Mirza, Assam and in Arogya Bhawans dormitories, Navi Mumbai.
- Helping the patients coming from different parts of India, Nepal and Bangladesh in the process of registration in the hospital guiding them during the initial days of their investigation.
- Providing daily free transport to patients and attendants in our vehicles from the shelter homes to hospitals both in Guwahati and Mumbai.
- Providing physical support in case of an operation.
- Providing medical aid to poor and needy cancer patients.
- Organizing blood for cancer patients as and when required.
- Ambulance services provided during emergencies.
- Helping in the transportation of Mortal remains to their homes.
- Liaison with specialist on behalf of patients who could not come to Mumbai.
- Procuring medicines at concessional rates.
- Helping patients with railway reservation in accordance with their concession forms.
- Arranging treatment in other speciality hospitals besides Tata Memorial Hospital.
- Rehabilitation training for the needy patients and their attendants.
- Helping patients to obtain prosthetic limbs.
- Organizing cancer screening and awareness camps.
- Entertainment programs and outings at regular intervals.
- Meals provided free at hospice centre, Mirza, Shisu Ashray Sthal, Guwahati, shelter home in Dibrugarh, Ratanlal Didwania Arogya Bhawan, Koparkhairane, Navi Mumbai and Deepsikha's Sadbhav Arogya Bhawan, Sector-28, Vashi, Navi Mumbai.
