From The Chairman's Desk...

As the years rolled by, we step into our 18th year. It has been a beautiful journey, sometimes smooth, sometimes bumpy, but never failing to be interesting and inspiring. It is all because of a wonderful team who do their bit silently and persistently. This is the secret of Deepsikha's success. It has been and will always be a story of dauntless hearts joining hands to make dreams come true. I salute this team at the very outset.

By the grace of the Almighty, we have been able to effectuate our commitment towards making the hospice for the terminally ill cancer patients at Mirza in the Kamrup district of Assam, operational since 7th of January 2016 onwards. A long felt need of the North-Eastern State of India was fulfilled and we started looking at death and the dying from a different perspective. A dignified death free from pain amidst an environment of love and care, to be run without charging a penny was our focus and we have been striving to achieve it since then.

We have commissioned a home for children suffering from cancer in 6th Mile Guwahati since 2018. Children from Assam and the Northeast who cannot afford accommodation are provided free stay along with food and transport. We have been getting magnanimous support from organizations to run this centre.

Project SURAKSHA, a free home care service started in 2024 which has been able to leave a deep impact in and around our hospice centre for patients who preferred the care at home. The team comprising of physician, nursing staff, medical social worker, psychologist and other transport staff has been doing commendable work in providing the much needed care, treatment and support.

In Mumbai, we have been providing meals to our patients and their relatives at a sum of Rs. 10/- along with accommodation and transport. Deepsikha is privileged enough to run a bhawan of the Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh and to cater to their needs. We are thankful to Didwania Ratanlal Charitable Trust and to Sadbhav Foundation for the support they have been providing us in running our Arogya bhawans in Navi Mumbai.

We added another service under Project SURAKSHA – the homecare service. The home visit by a dedicated team provides medical care directly at the patient's residence. This service offers convenience for individuals who have difficulty in travelling to a clinic or hospital.

Whatever meaning Deepsikha has been able to add in the crusade against cancer has been possible due to the unstinted commitment of the Deepsikha team. As we continue to weave this beautiful tapestry called Deepsikha, I cannot help but thank you all for your indomitable spirit and dedication. God bless you all.

Last but not the least, Deepsikha salutes the unflinching spirit of all the fighters who had fought so bravely and courageously against cancer.

Deepsikha's annual reports for the year (2024-2025) represents the efforts of each and everyone including volunteers and interns who have made a huge difference in the lives of those people who want a helping hand. The activities of Deepsikha range from awareness to screening, to providing financial aid, free accommodation, food, transport, medicines and medical services to those patients who cannot afford treatment.

The highlights of this year were –

- ➔ Financial assistance and handholding by Azim Premji Foundation (APF) for our hospice and Homecare service under Project 'SURAKSHA'.
- ➔ Free mammogram, ECG and USG for patients in the district of Morigaon, Dibrugarh and in various places in and around Guwahati.
- ➔ Donation of a 'Traveller' vehicle for awareness and screening by Life Insurance Corporation of India (LIC), Guwahati.
- ➔ We are immensely thankful to Lions' Club of Narengi for providing protein powder to our patients.
- ➔ We celebrated 'World No Tobacco Day' with awareness programmes and street plays in strategic locations at Guwahati.
- ➔ The Shishu Ashray Stal (SAS) has been able to touch the lives of innocent children to cope up with the treatment by staying with their parents or guardians. Until now, we have touched 4162 no. of children. This Centre offers free services with the support from SBI (Life).
- ➔ The Hospice centre providing free treatment and care to terminally ill patients under the guidance of experienced Doctors and Nursing staff.
- ➔ We are thankful to India Carbon Limited under the aegis of 'Manav Kalyan Trust' for providing us with medicines and medical items for our patients.
- ➔ We are grateful to 'Indian Oil Corporation (IOCL)' for providing an elevator in our Hospice centre.
- ➔ We thank 'Trinity Fructa' for offering their assistance to conduct cancer-screening programmes.
- ➔ Deepsikha is thankful to SBI (Mutual Fund) for providing a 42-seater bus in our Mumbai unit for transporting cancer patients from our Arogya bhawan to the treating hospital.

Our Services to Cancer Patients

- Voluntary service at B. Barooah Cancer Hospital and Tata Memorial Hospital Help Desk cum Enquiry Counter.
- Providing free accommodation to needy cancer patients at Deepsikha's Sishu Ashray Sthal in Guwahati, shelter home in Dibrugarh, hospice centre in Mirza, Assam and in Arogya Bhawans dormitories, Navi Mumbai.
- Helping the patients coming from different parts of India, Nepal and Bangladesh in the process of registration in the hospital guiding them during the initial days of their investigation.
- Providing daily free transport to patients and attendants in our vehicles from the shelter homes to hospitals both in Guwahati and Mumbai.
- Providing physical support in case of an operation.
- Providing medical aid to poor and needy cancer patients.
- Organizing blood for cancer patients as and when required.
- Ambulance services provided during emergencies.
- Helping in the transportation of Mortal remains to their homes.
- Liaison with specialist on behalf of patients who could not come to Mumbai.
- Procuring medicines at concessional rates.
- Helping patients with railway reservation in accordance with their concession forms.
- Arranging treatment in other speciality hospitals besides Tata Memorial Hospital.
- Rehabilitation training for the needy patients and their attendants.
- Helping patients to obtain prosthetic limbs.
- Organizing cancer screening and awareness camps.
- Free home care service under project SURAKSHA.
- Entertainment programs and outings at regular intervals.
- Meals provided free at Hospice centre, Mirza, Shisu Ashray Sthal, Guwahati, Shelter home in Dibrugarh, Ratanlal Didwania Arogya Bhawan, Koparkhairane, Navi Mumbai and Deepsikha's Sadbhav Arogya Bhawan, Sector-28, Vashi, Navi Mumbai.

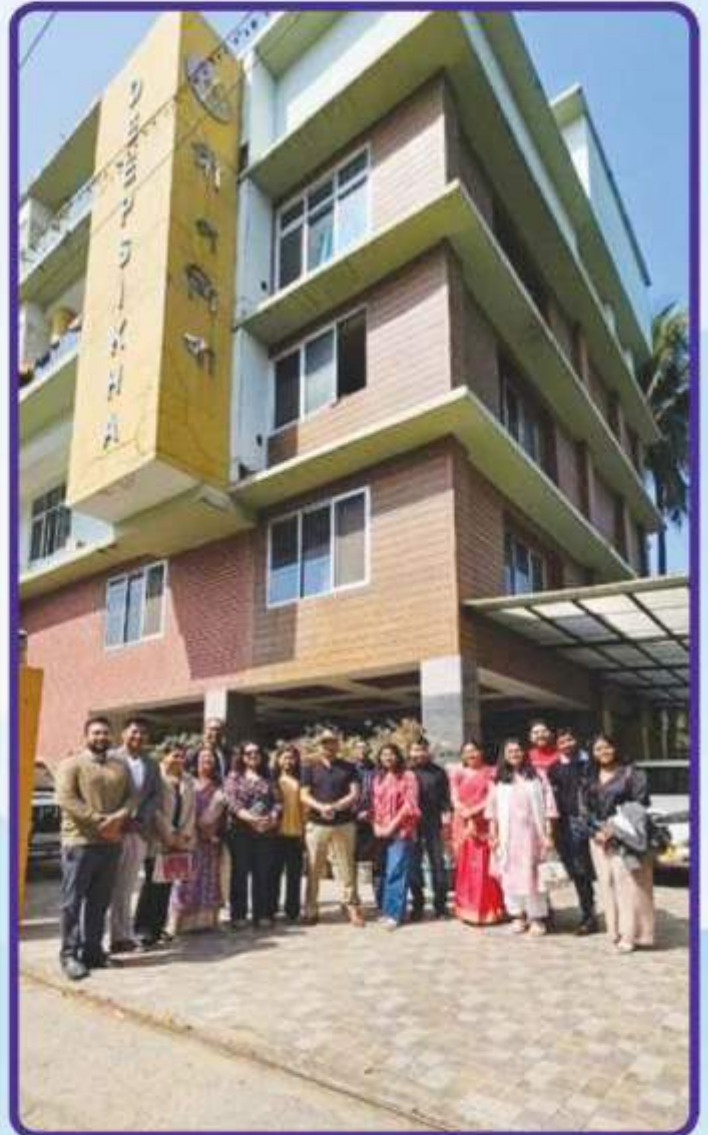

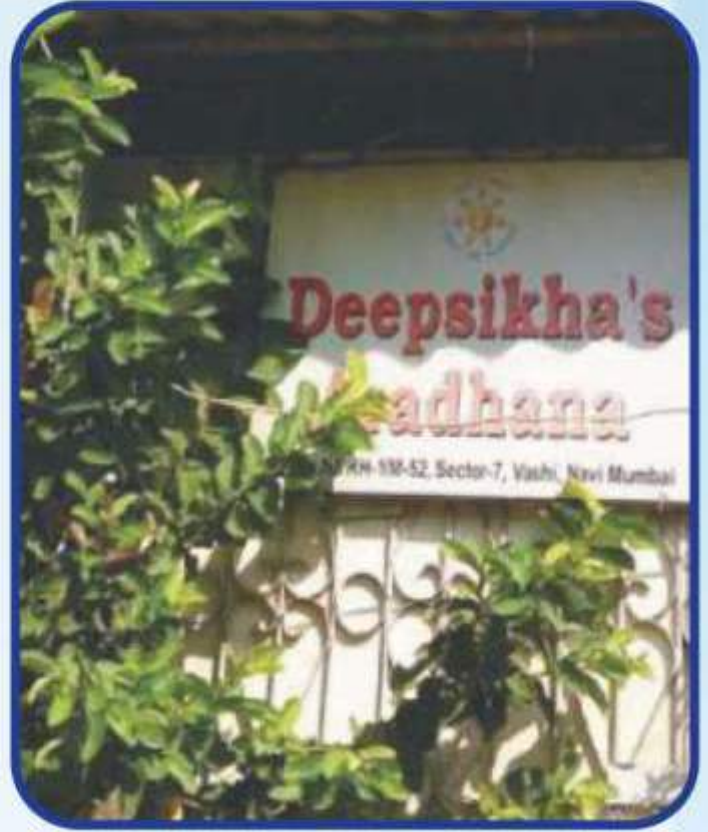

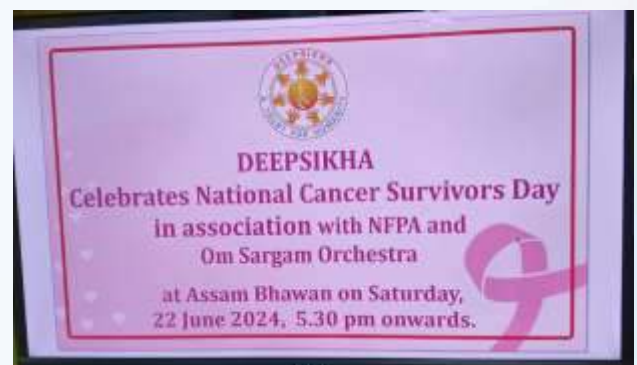

Dahi poha.

Ingredients: poha 2cup, curd 3/4cup, 1 teaspoon oil, rai, whole dry chilli, curry leaves, salt. wash the poha and keep it aside for 10 min. Then add the curd to it and mix.

Heat the oil in a vessel and add the rai, chilly, curry leaves and let them splutter.

Add this to the poha and curd mixture and mix.

Add salt to taste and garnish with chopped coriander.

Dahi poha (sweet)

Ingredients: poha 1cup, Curd 3/4cup, cut fruits like banana, mango, apple (as available), chopped dates and some nuts.

Mix all the ingredients and a delicious and healthy breakfast is ready.

Dalia khichdi

Ingredients: dalia 1/2 of medium katori, moong dal or soaked whole moong 1/2 of medium katori, some chopped vegetables like, beans, capsicum, green peas, grated carrot etc. jeera, and whole dry red chilli for seasoning, 1 teaspoon oil and 1/teaspoon ghee(optional, little garam masala powder, salt.

Wash and soak the Dalia and moong for 1/2 an hour, Heat oil in a vessel. Add the jeera, chilly, hing. Let them splutter. Add a pinch of haldi and the vegetables. Cook for 2-3min. Add little grated ginger and the soaked Dalia and moong. Mix all the ingredients. Then add 2 times water (warm) ,salt and little garam masala. Cook till all the water is absorbed, add little ghee. Nutritous khichdi is ready.

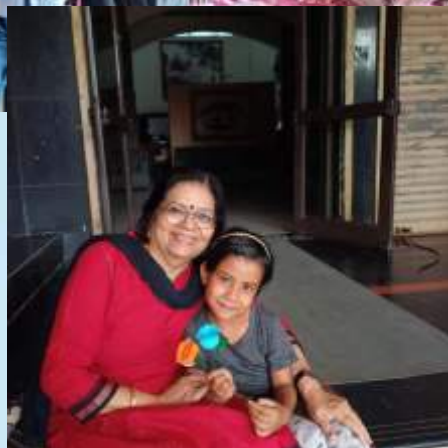

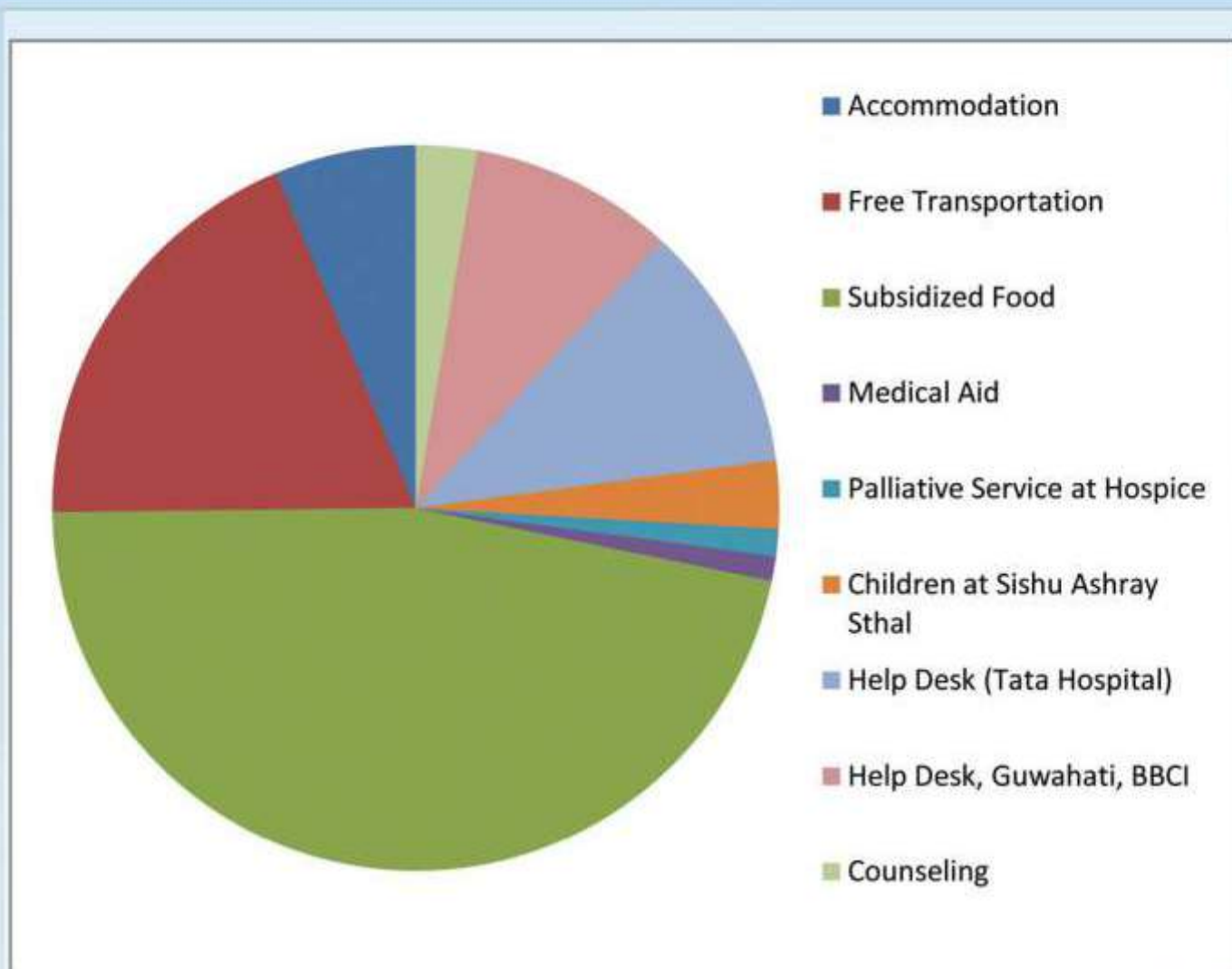
